CLINTON EMERGENCY SERVICES FOUNDATION



The **Clinton Emergency Services Foundation's** mission is to raise funds for the purchase of emergency services equipment essential to the firefighting, rescue and EMS efforts conducted by the Clinton Fire Department and the Clinton First Aid & Rescue Squad. Both organizations provide services to the Town of Clinton, as well as portions of neighboring communities in Hunterdon County.

The Clinton Fire Department is located in the heart of downtown Clinton, Hunterdon County, New Jersey.

The responsibilities of the Clinton Fire Department include, but are not limited to, responding to fire and rescue calls, fire prevention education, fire suppression at motor vehicle accidents and community recreational support.

The Department is primarily responsible for the protection of Clinton’s population of over 2,600 in an area of approximately 1.2 square miles. The Department also provides coverage for parts of the neighboring towns of Franklin and Union Townships, as well as portions of Interstate Route 78.

The Clinton Fire Department also provides mutual aid to other communities of Hunterdon County when requested, on an as needed basis.

The Clinton First Aid & Rescue Squad is a non-profit organization providing pre-hospital emergency medical services and technical rescue services, including vehicle extraction, to the Town of Clinton as well as portions of Clinton Township, Lebanon Borough, Franklin Township, Union Township and Interstate Route 78, a total primary coverage area of approximately 48 square miles.

The Clinton Squad responds to over 2,400 dispatches per year.

The Clinton First Aid & Rescue Squad utilizes a hybrid combination of paid and volunteer emergency Medical Technicians (EMT’s). Unique in Hunterdon County, the Squad always has a first call response team in the building 24/7.

The Squad operates five ambulances, a rescue truck, a special services / marine support truck, 3 boats, a command vehicle, and a technical rescue services trailer.
