Dear Merchant:

The Town of Clinton officially adopted its amended "Sign Ordinance" on Tuesday March 25, 2008. This Ordinance is available in the office at 47 Leigh Street at NO COST. It will also be available on the Town of Clinton website, www.clintonnj.gov.

The Town would like to provide adequate time for each business to comply with the new guidelines of this ordinance. Therefore, the Town will allow a 60 day period for each business to apply for a sign permit as needed. If a permit is denied, the business owner can apply to the Board of Adjustment for a sign variance, or simply remove the sign in question. This 60- day period will end on June 2, 2008. If you have already received a construction permit for a sign AND the sign installed has been inspected and approved, no further action is needed on your part. However, if this permit is not closed out with an approved inspection, you must contact the construction department to rectify this matter.
