



## CANCELLATION OF ELECTRONICS RECYCLING COLLECTION

As you are aware, for many years the Town of Clinton has been able to provide free electronics recycling for residents through a 3rd party, Newtech Recycling. Since the law does not permit any electronics to be discarded in the regular trash, this was an excellent way residents could dispose of their used electronics in an environmentally safe manner. However, late yesterday afternoon we were notified by Newtech Recycling that they will no longer be able to provide the services that we currently take advantage of at no cost to the Town. Due to the lateness of the hour in which we were notified, as well as the exorbitant costs imposed by the vendor, the Town cannot continue to provide this service through the current vendor as it is just too cost-prohibitive. This means, that as of Wednesday, December 30, 2015, residents will no longer be able to drop of any electronics to be recycled.

With this in mind, the Town is going to be exploring alternative options with the hope that we can reinstate this service in the near future. Until then, we encourage all residents to take advantage of the electronics recycling services offered through the Hunterdon County Division of Solid Waste and Recycling Services.
