

The Town of Clinton is considering a Community Energy Aggregation (CEA) Program for the residents of Clinton. The CEA Program is designed to offer you and your neighbors **reduced rates on your electric bill.**

CEA is a system to aggregate the buying power of individual customers within a municipality to secure reduced rate energy supply contracts on a community-wide basis, and allow consumers not wishing to participate an option to opt out once automatically enrolled. All current services such as delivery, meter readings, billing, payments, emergency services, etc., **DO NOT CHANGE.** Actually, not much changes other than a smaller monthly bill. This program is very different than individual 3rd party supply contracts and offers consumer protections that aren't typically available outside this program.
